The Miner Board of Aldermen met in special session on October 28, 2010 at 5:30 p.m. in the Miner Court Room. The meeting was posted in the foyer of city hall and sent to the Standard-Democrat newspaper.

Mayor Pro-tem Charles McLemore called the meeting to order since Mayor Frank Tatum was ill. Roll call: Charles McLemore - present, Rickie Hampton - present, Peggy Holman - present, Deloris Smith - present. Also attending was Chief of Police Chris Griggs. City Clerk, Danielle Patrick, was present to record the minutes.

NEW BUSINESS

A. ALLOWING THE CHAMBER LUNCHEON TO BE HELD AT THE MINER CONVENTION CENTER DECEMBER 16, 2010.

Clerk, Danielle Patrick, informed everyone that she had been contacted by Missy Marshall with the Chamber asking if the City would allow the Chamber Luncheon to be held at the Miner Convention Center. The Clerk then also explained that Missy Marshall informed her that they did not pay to rent convention halls. After much discussion a motion was made by Rickie Hampton and seconded by Peggy Holman not to allow the Chamber to hold their luncheon at the Convention Center for free. A roll call vote was taken with all ayes.

B. POLICE DEPARTMENT TRAINING

Police Chief Griggs stated that officer Mitzlaff had come to him asking to allow him attend Street Crime Training in St. Louis. Chief Griggs explained to everyone that Officer Mitzlaff has never been to any type of training since he has been employed with the City. The cost of the training is estimated to be around \$600 with Mitzlaff taking his own vehicle and it will be paid for out of the Police Training Fund. A motion was made by Peggy Holman and seconded by Rickie Hampton to allow Michael Mitzlaff to attend the training. Alderwoman Deloris Smith asked Chief Griggs about the overtime that could possibly be incurred and he assured everyone that there would not be any overtime. A roll call vote was taken with all ayes.

C. CLOSING CITY HALL FROM 12-1 FOR LUNCH


Clerk, Danielle Patrick, explained to the Board that she felt that City Hall needed to be closed from the hours of 12 to 1 daily so that everyone could have his or her lunch hour. The Clerk informed everyone that it could be put on the water bills next month as well as posting a sign in the window to let people know that City Hall will be closed. After much discussion a motion was made by Deloris Smith and seconded by Peggy Holman to close City Hall daily for lunch between the hours of 12 and 1. A roll call vote was taken with all ayes.

D. MOVING CHIEF GRIGGS AND CAPTAIN STEWART'S OFFICE

Chief Griggs and Captain Stewart approached the Board asking if they could go ahead and move into the old City Hall offices. Chief Griggs stated that he would like to move into the old Mayor's office and Captain Stewart would like to move into the Clerk's old office. Alderman McLemore stated that the only problem that he could see with them moving into the Mayor's old office is on court day. Chief Griggs assured everyone that he has a locking file cabinet that he will make sure his desk is clear and all files are locked up on court day when the attorneys and judge use his office for court. A motion was made by Rickie and seconded by Peggy Holman to allow the offices to be moved as requested by Chief Griggs and Captain Stewart. A roll call vote was taken with all ayes.

With all business concluded a motion was made by Peggy Holman and seconded by Rickie Hampton to adjourn. A roll call vote was taken with all ayes.
