The Miner Board of Aldermen met for a special meeting on March 5, 2012 at 5:15 p.m. The meeting was posted in the foyer of city hall and sent to the Standard-Democrat newspaper.

Mayor Frank Tatum called the meeting to order. Roll call: Charles McLemore - present, Rickie Hampton - present, Peggy Holman - present, Deloris Smith - present. Also attending was Marvin Hatton and Chief of Police Chris Griggs. City Clerk, Danielle Patrick, was present to record the minutes and Joe Fuchs was in his capacity as City Attorney.


NEW BUSINESS

- A. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 109, 258, 395, 460, 465, 657, 667, 672, AND 714 PROVIDING FOR TWO ADDITIONAL STOP SIGNS.
Mayor Tatum presented bill No. 1024 adding two 2-way stops signs on Railroad Street East and West bound at the Drury Inn and Malone entrance and the Pear Tree Inn and Malone Entrance. A motion was made by Charles McLemore and seconded by Deloris to place the bill on its first, second and third readings. The Clerk read the bill and followed with a roll call vote. Deloris Smith- yes, Rickie Hampton –yes, Charles McLemore- yes, and Peggy Holman – Yes. Mayor Tatum announced that Bill 1024 had become Ordinance 1013.
- B. SENDING PATROL OFFICER TO TASER TRAINING- CHIEF GRIGGS
Chief of Police Chris Griggs approached the Mayor and the Board asking to send Officer James Buckley to taser training to become a taser instructor since Officer James Tigart was the instructor and is no longer with the City. Chief Griggs explained that having someone certified as an instructor will save the City money because we can train in house instead of having to send each officer off to be recertified every two years. Griggs stated that the estimated cost to send the officer to training is going to cost roughly \$600. A motion was made by Charles McLemore and it was seconded Rickie Hampton to send Officer James Buckley to taser instructor school in St. Louis. A roll call vote followed with all ayes.
- C. CHANGING APRIL MONTHLY MEETING TO APRIL 9, 2012
Mayor Tatum stated that he felt it necessary to move the regular April meeting up to the second Monday which is April 9, 2012, so the Clerk would have time to complete the meeting items before her maternity leave. A motion was made by Charles McLemore and seconded by Rickie Hampton. A roll call vote followed with all ayes.

With all business concluded a motion was made by Rickie Hampton and seconded by Charles McLemore to adjourn to executive as per RSMo. 610.021.3 (Personnel) & RSMo. 610.021.1 (Legal). A roll call vote was taken with all ayes.
